

Guidelines for Walking Dogs - Seven Gates Residents

The Landscape Committee would like to remind dog owners of the following courtesies which should be shown to your neighbors.

- Please keep your dog on a leash when your dog is outside.
- Please train your dog to pee and poop in the pine-needled plant beds around your house or in the pine-needled plant beds along New Garden Road and Northlake Drive.
- Please train your dog to not use the grass or pine-needled areas around your neighbors' homes.
- Regardless of where your dog poops, please pick up the dropping and dispose of the poop bag in your garbage can.
- It is suggested that you carry bottled water when you walk your dog in the community to pour on the grass or shrubs should your dog accidentally pee or poop on any of the grassy areas or plantings within Seven Gates. Dog urine does kill fescue grass.
- When walking your dog please show the same level of respect for your neighbors in the adjacent neighborhood as you would your Seven Gates neighbors.

If you see someone not picking up after his or her dog, please remind that person in a friendly manner of the Seven Gates rules. If you see someone consistently disregarding these rules, please notify Lambeth Management. Pet owners will be held liable for damage to plantings or to the grassy areas caused by their pets.
