REQUEST Guidelines

<u>Tree Removal</u>: Trees are essential for the reduction of pollutants in the atmosphere, the prevention of soil erosion, and the enhancement of the appearance of Friendly West. Their removal is not taken lightly. However, circumstances do arise that warrant tree removal, replacement or treatment.

<u>Off-Schedule Trimming:</u> Shrubs and Small Trees (up to 14ft high) are pruned completely twice a year and as needed for dead pruning and corrective pruning. If desired, and approved by the FW Landscaping Committee, trees and shrubs may be trimmed more frequently (off-schedule). This work is typically performed as a chargeable service unless a small job approved by the Landscape Committee.

Plant Replacement: Replacement of Healthy Plant Material is generally denied. If approved,

the work is typically performed as a chargeable service.

<u>landscape Design Change:</u> Any type of alteration to the current landscape layout must include a design plan with description. It is also to include a list of plants and/or materials (stepping stones, blocks, pavers, etc.) that are to be considered if applicable.

REASON Guidelines

<u>Structural/Sewer Damage</u>: Damage to buildings, sidewalks, sewer pipes, or other facilities

may justify removal if corrective measures are not practical.

<u>Overgrown/Crowded:</u> Trees or Plants that have outgrown the available space may justify removal.

Damaged/Declining Health: Trees or plants that are declining in health will be evaluated for

corrective action before removal/replacement is considered.

<u>View Blockage</u>: By nature view blockage must be reviewed case by case to determine the best

course of action.

<u>Litter and Debris:</u> Because all trees shed litter seasonally, generally this is not an adequate reason to justify removal. However, if granted, removal/replacement may be at owner's expense.

<u>Personal Preference</u>: Because one does not like the appearance or other characteristics of the tree or shrub/plant does not justify its removal. However, if granted, removal/replacement is usually at owner's expense.
