## Peaceford Meadows Homeowners Association Swimming Pool Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all members of the Peaceford Meadows Homeowners Association to assure safe and sanitary operation of the pool.

#### General

1. ACCESS TO POOL - The main front door is set on a timer that will unlock each day at 8:00 am and will remain unlocked until 8:30 pm. You then will access the door opening to the pool by using your proximity access card.

To **Exit** the pool area, press the **GREEN** button to the right of the door. This releases the latch, and then opens the door to exit. **NOTE:** The pool door will automatically lock after 8:30 PM and there will be no way to exit the area.

- POOL RULES The following rules are designed to reiterate and specify the rules that
  are listed on the signs posted at the pool (as required by the Health Department). The
  printed rules as well as the posted rules are to be adhered to at all times by members and
  their guest.
  - A. Doors are to remain closed at all times.
  - B. An adult must accompany children under the age of 14 at all times.
  - C. The wading pool is for residents five (5) years of age and under.
  - D. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk and Peacford Meadows Homeowners Association assumes no responsibility for injury or damage resulting from such use.
  - E. In case of emergency, call 911.
  - F. Homeowners and residents are responsible for guests and minors.
  - G. Additional access cards available at \$10.00 each

#### 3. POOL HOURS

- A. Normal hours: 8:00 am- 8:30 pm daily (No night swimming allowed). **RESTRICTED HOURS** (Adults only: Tuesday and Thursday 7:00 pm-8:30 pm).
- B. Pool will be closed during electrical storms or operational problems
- C. Pool is not to be used unless officially opened.

#### 4. DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

- A. Personal- The association will not be responsible for any loss of damage to personal property brought into the pool or clubhouse area
- B. Association- Members are responsible for damage to Association property caused by themselves or their guest.

# 1. <u>POOL SAFETY AND ENFORCEMENT OF RULES - NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY - SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.</u>

- A. There is no lifeguard on duty. All swimmers do so at their own risk. The Association and the Management Company will not be held responsible for any accidents or injuries arising out of the use of the pool by a member or guest or for loss or damage to personal property of any kind.
- B. Children under the age of 14 are not permitted to use the pool without the continued supervision of an Adult. Adult shall be defined for the purpose of these Rules as someone age 18 or over, or a family member or paid sitter over the age of 16. Identification and/or proof of age will be required.
- C. One Adult for every 5 children under the age of 14 shall be required continuous supervision.
- D. The following are prohibited in the pool area: running, pushing, shoving or throwing people in the pool, tag games, spitting, chewing gum, swearing or profanity. No disruptive manners will be tolerated.
- E. Floats will be permitted if there is no metal on them and they do not crowd the pool. Arm floatation devices for younger children will be allowed in the big pool with adult supervision. The Board of Directors and the pool committee members reserve the right to prohibit any such items as necessary for the common good. No boats, kayaks or boogie boards are allowed in the pool area.
- F. The Board of Directors and the pool committee are authorized to interpret and enforce all rules regarding pool usage. This authority includes the expulsion of individuals from the pool area if they do not obey the rules.
- G. Pool chemicals in concentrated form are poisonous; therefore, no one is permitted in the pool equipment room.

### 2. Swimming Pool - Health

- A. Shower before entering the pool.
- B. All persons, especially children are requested to use the toilet facilities before entering the pool.
- C. Persons with skin eruptions, open sores, bandages, etc. are not permitted to use the pool.
- D. No smoking, eating or drinking allowed within  $\underline{5}$  feet of the pool's edge.
- E. Absolutely <u>no glass</u> containers permitted at the pool.
- F. All cigarette butts, candy wrappers, paper cups, etc. must be placed in trash receptacles. Please take responsibility for cleaning up any debris upon your departure.
- G. No pets allowed in clubhouse or pool area.
- H. No cut off pants, tennis shorts or Bermuda shorts allowed in the pool. Please wear proper bathing suit attire.
- I. No suntan lotion containing oil or grease (oil clogs filter) allowed in pool.
- J. IN CASE OF EMERGENCY CALL 911.

Pool committee volunteers will be monitoring the facility and randomly asking for identification. The pool is an attractive gathering spot for all residents. If each resident follows these rules, the enjoyment of this special facility will be enhanced. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
