## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned, being of the age of eighteen years or more profiled does hereby make and acknowledge these Articles of Incorporation of STATE for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under and by the contract of the laws of the State of North Carolina.

- 1. The name of the corporation is POLO FARMS HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.
  - 2. The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.
- 3. The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to engage in the activities necessary or convenient for the purpose of operating, managing, maintaining, repairing, beautifying and preserving the Common Property of Polo Farms Subdivision, Guilford County, North Carolina, as from time to time expanded, including without limitation, the exercise of the rights and acts and collection of assessments provided for by the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions of Polo Farms Subdivision as from time to time amended and supplemented, which Declaration is, as amended and supplemented, is of record in the Public Registry of Guilford County, North Carolina.
