IV. Business

- a. Limbs over unit 508 parking spaces and limb over unit 508
 - The Board voted to have these limbs removed or cut back. Lambeth Property Management was getting bids to have this work completed.

 - i. Lambeth Property Management is reviewing finances and making recommendations for the Board to follow to maintain the property.

- e. Landscape Update
 - i. The Board voted to approve the \$450 required to clear the overgrown foliage between units 540 and 542.
 - ii. Pine Needles
 - The HOA Board will pay for pine needles in the common areas and in front of individual units, unless property owners prefer to spread mulch or bark at their own expense. Those wishing the latter option, will be given a time in which to complete this work prior to the pine needles being spread throughout the property.

iii. Bamboo

- 1. Lambeth Property Management is getting a quote to better manage the bamboo that is multiplying.
- iv. Landscaping Day
 - 1. Black Dog has moved its work day from Tuesdays to Fridays.
- v. Noise reduction trees

1. The Board has been notified of an option to purchase multiple fast-growing trees that cost approximately \$130 for ten. A plan will be put in place to determine how many trees are needed and in what placement in order to reduce the noise from Friendly Avenue. These trees grow between 3 and 4 feet annually. More will be reported on this in coming months.
